Some sites will charge up to \$800 to guarantee you a minimum amount of aid. THESE PROMISES, LISTS AND GUARANTEES ARE NOT POSSIBLE. To identify false claims, consult <a href="https://www.ftc.gov/scholarshipscams">www.ftc.gov/scholarshipscams</a>. Beware of services that "do all the work for you." **Students must apply themselves for scholarships and grants**. Never give out credit card or bank account info to "hold a scholarship."
