ALWAYS a TORNADO!: Former Malden High star Felicia Lombardi scores Gamewinning Goal for Coast Guard Academy over WPI in 2–1 win

NEW LONDON, Conn. - U.S. Coast Guard Academy battled back from an early one goal deficit to take down WPI 2-1 in New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) action Saturday afternoon.

With the win, the Bears improve to 4-3-0 overall and 1-1-0 in conference play. The Engineers drop to 5-4-0 on the season and 0-2-0 in the NEWMAC.

Freshman Brielle Pearce and sophomore Felicia Lombardi, a former Malden High School multi-sport standout, both scored for Coast Guard while junior Claire Hurley and sophomore Kat Retz each had an assist. Hurley leads the NEWMAC with six assists on the year and is one off the single season record held by Sarah Giardina who had seven assists in 2000.

1. Sign-in to X2

2. In the upper right hand corner, click on your name

4. Click the Security tab

5. For PRIMARY email address, please be sure your school email address is listed. Do not use a personal email address in this field. Please put personal email addresses in the alternate email field.
