- I. Enrollment Update
 - A.) There are 264 tuition-based students. This is up from February's figure of 238.
 - B.) As of March 27, 2017, the total ELC enrollment is 375 students. This is an increase from February's figure of 359.
- II. After School Programming 2017-2018
 - A.) The ELC has outsourced its After School program to AlphaBEST. This decision was based upon the following reasons:
 - i) Better for Families
 - ii) Programmatic
 - iii) More support
 - B.) AlphaBEST is a nation-wide after school childcare program. Based on Kaplan's educational system, AlphaBEST combines both learning and fun for students.

i) The price will actually be the same or less than the price of the current program.
ii) AlphaBEST accepts vouchers, offers several discounts and drop-in programs, and provides snacks.

- III. Kindergarten Registration
 - A.) ELC Families have been given priority registration and they are able to register their children at the ELC whereas prior to this, families needed to go to the Parent Information Center.
 - B.) Malden Public Schools hold an info session for children entering kindergarten at each child's school in the summer.

- E.) Rebecca will email staff to ask ELC parents if they are Community Helpers.
- F.) Kerrin will contact JRM Hauling and Recycling.
