This was one of the cuts we made to this year's budget it had a price tag of \$400,000. We did not take a formal vote of this subcommittee, we were in agreement that there was no way we would be able to come up with the needed money without cutting somewhere else in the budget.

4. Because we will not have a budget figure from the mayor for FY18, everything is fluid and discussions take place but without a figure no real decisions can be reached.
