This summer the Partnership for Community Schools is your <u>one stop for summer fun</u>! From enrichment to arts and crafts to recreational activities, there is something for everyone. Our programs are open to students entering grades K-8 and will run from June 25 to August 3. So—please join us at the Salemwood School for an enjoyable and productive summer!

Summer Camps

We will offer two separate programs for students entering grades K-5 and those entering grades 6-8, with six weeks of programming that is engaging, dynamic, and enriching. Your children will not only have fun, but they will have the chance to explore new topics that will help them build their academic skills. In both programs, we will incorporate literature to build reading comprehension and development; while students will also be involved in hands-on experiences that will help them develop competencies and make learning connections beyond those in a typical classroom. Each program will follow similar weekly themes as outlined below.

Vacation Station Enrichment Camp (entering grades K-5)

For students entering grades K-5,our summer camps will be available Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. You may select any combination of days and weeks to fit your schedule—however we do require you register for a minimum of two days per week. Each week will feature a unique theme and will include a combination of enrichment, sports, and recreational activities.

The cost for our full-day program is \$45 per day. You may also select a half-day program: 8:00 am to 12:00 noon for \$20 per day, or 12:00 noon to 5:00 pm for \$25 per day. There is a one-time registration fee of \$10 per child for registrations received in our office by June 1. After June 1 the registration fee is \$25. We also offer a 15% sibling discount.

Vacation Station Channel Surfing (entering grades 6-8)

Join your friends this summer for Vacation Station Channel Surfing. In order to make this program more accessible to middle school students—you may select the weeks you want to attend. The only requirement is that you attend a minimum of two weeks during the summer. Our summer Channel Surfing program will feature a different theme each week and includes time for enrichment, sports, and recreation.

Vacation Station Channel Surfing is available Monday through Thursday each week—from 12:00 noon to 5:00 pm. The fee is only \$25 for the entire summer—whether you attend two or six weeks!! Due to grant requirements, summer Channel Surfing is only available to Malden residents.

Wide World of Animals

As the summer kicks off we will learn about animal from around the world, what animals are now considered endangered, and how we can help these animals. Students will also learn about the role animal shelters play in their community and why these sanctuaries are so important to neglected and abandoned animals.

Week of July 2

As we celebrate our Nation's birthday we will explore some of America's greatest heroes. We will learn about the contributions they made and the importance of those contributions. Because of the July 4th holiday, this will be a shortened week .

Want to learn more about the music industry, theater, and movies? Then this is the week for you! During the week we'll analyze some of today's most popular movies, learn about headlining music artists from today and the past, and find out what it's like to be on stage. This is your chance to shine!
