- Mornings

Please note there is no supervision outside before 7:45 and there is no nurse on the premises.

- Afternoons

- 7-8 students are dismissed at 2:20
- K-6 students are dismissed at 2:15
- Please note there is limited supervision outside in the afternoons (for only 10 minutes after dismissal); please be prompt and/or make arrangements for your child to have a destination once dismissed. There is no nurse on the premises after dismissal.
- It is important that your child know their after school plan
