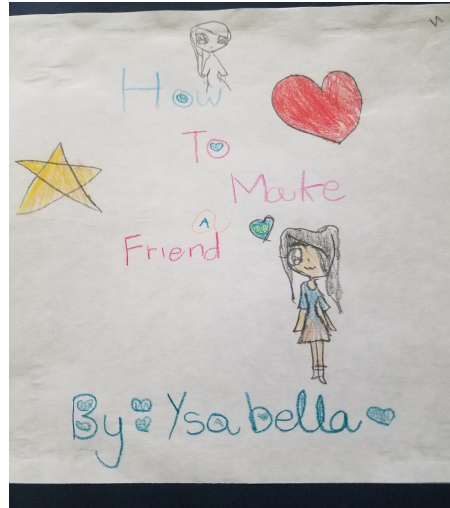
A Project by Ms. Pelegrino and 2nd Grade

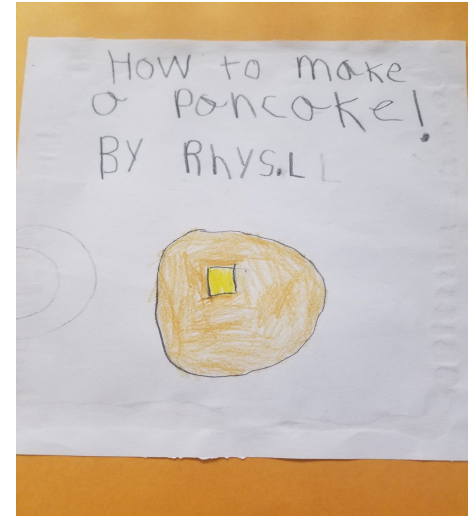
1. First, you get a flower and try to tie it up/ask a parent to help you. :) You also get a string.
