- ❖ **City of Malden Municipal Scholarship** Notification: The City of Malden Municipal Scholarship application will be available starting Monday, February 8, 2016 to any Malden resident seeking further education resulting in a degree, diploma, or certificate. The only requirement when applying is that the resident must have lived in the City of Malden for at least 2 years prior to Sunday, May 1, 2016. You may pick up an application in the City Clerk's Office or the Malden Public Library. Completed applications are to be turned in to the City Clerk's Office NO LATER than Wednesday, May 11, 2016. **Please talk up the scholarship process to our seniors. They have to do some work; apply, follow up, submit supporting documents etc.**
