Program Structure

Goal: To reduce retention rates by tutoring students who are academically off-track

- FREE tutoring with Malden High School Teachers
- March 1 - June 11, 2021
- Limited spots - Early Bird Deadline is March 5th!
- VIRTUAL After-school Tutoring (week days after 2:45pm, weekends)
- Up to five hours per student per week
- Subjects: ELA, Math, Sciences, History, World Language, & some electives upon request
- Individualized Support & Small Groups
- Bi-weekly Progress Reports

Expectations



- Complete Registration.
- Attend scheduled sessions for entire period of time.
 - 2 no shows = warning;
 - 3 no shows = dropped from the program
- Communicate with tutor at least 24 hours in advance when unable to attend session.
- Arrive on time.
 - More than 15 min. late = session cancellation
- Come prepared to work.

Communication



- Families/caregivers and Students will receive bi-weekly progress reports.
- Tutors will reach out to students' teachers as needed.

Progress Monitoring & Tracking

The following indicators will be collected and monitored to assess student progress:

- Student attendance at tutoring sessions
- Grades (X2)
- Assignment completion
- Pre-Post student survey
- Bi-weekly Progress Reports
- Quarterly Progress Reports - In Danger of Failing (comment 320)
