School and Community Overview

Accredited by the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, Malden High School offers core academic courses in Mathematics, English, Arts, Science, Social Studies and World Languages. Outside of the core academic areas, students can take courses in Fine Arts, Business, Technical Education, Physical Education, and Health.

Currently, our enrollment is 1775 students. Our student body is a diverse one, with more than 80 countries and 50 languages represented. Students presently take courses at the levels of College Prep, Honors, Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment/Early College, in conjunction with Bunker Hill Community College. Malden High School has a rich and proud history of graduating outstanding students who go on to become valuable members of our global community.

Graduation Requirements

All students must pass the Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System (MCAS) tests in Mathematics, English Language Arts & Science. Students not meeting the MCAS requirement but meeting all of the local MHS graduation requirements receive a certificate at graduation and not a Malden High School diploma. In addition to passing the MCAS, students must pass a minimum of 21 units (combination of full-year credits and half-year credits) based on the following:

- 4 units of English (9th, 10th, 11th, 12th grade English)
- 4 units of Mathematics, one of which must be an Algebra Course
- 3 units of Science, one of which must be Biology (with lab requirement)
- 3 units of Social Sciences, (US1, US2, and World History)
- 2 units of Wellness (Physical Education and Health)
- 2 units from among the following disciplines: Business, Technology Education, Fine and Performing Arts
- 3 core/elective units from any discipline

2020 Covid-19 Pandemic Learning & Grading Statement

Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Pass/Fail grading was assigned March-June of the 2019-2020 academic school year. Grades from the 2019-20 school year are not calculated into the overall student GPA. In 2020-2021, we have altered our maximum academic capacity to six courses per school year, from seven courses in prior years. We are beginning the 20-21 school year in a remote learning environment.
