PBIS is an approach schools can use to improve school safety and promote positive behavior. We are in our first year of this program and we are focusing on cafeteria,

hallways, recess, & bathroom behavior. At the Linden school we have adopted three core practices: Safe, Responsible, Respectful. Students are encouraged to follow those guidelines throughout the school. Tickets are given to students modeling those practices.

Coffee and Conversation- Join the administration for our first "Coffee and Conversation" on October 23rd at 8:15am. We will have a discussion on what PBIS is and what it looks like at our school.

Rewards for PBIS

Students are informed as to why they earned a ticket and get to put their ticket in the jug out front of the office. Once the jug gets filled to a certain point, a lucky student gets to choose the reward for the entire school. Each Friday two to five tickets are drawn. Those students receive a special prize from the office. Each month all classrooms in grades K-8 will select students that exemplify our core practices, and they will be a student of the month. Next time you are in the school check out all the tickets the students have earned!
