


MONTH #6: YOUR wages increase substantially for every 1,000 work hours and for every 150 school hours you complete as predetermined by the state;

Pre-Apprenticeship Program Leadership Academy at Malden High School

Malden Superintendent of Schools John Oteri is pleased to report that Malden High School has signed an agreement with Associated Builders and Contractors, Inc., Merit Apprenticeship Program, to offer pre- apprentice and leadership training. Training will include 75 hours of general construction, OSHA 10, and hoisting training, followed by placement. Classes will be held later this month in the Maker Space at Malden High School in the late afternoon and evening hours on Tuesdays and Thursdays. An additional class will be held on Wednesday evenings for Malden High School Seniors beginning in June where youth will receive training in OSHA- 10 and Construction Math, with the opportunity to move into the full pre-apprentice program.
