

MINUTES OF THE EXECUTIVE SESSION  
OF THE MALDEN SCHOOL COMMITTEE  
Monday, November 13, 2017  
Malden Senior Center, 7 Washington Street

Mayor Christenson called the meeting to order at 8:01 pm.

1. Collective Bargaining (Grievance SEIU)

Attorney Greenspan informed that the discussion will be about the response to the Level 3 grievance from the SEIU Local 888 clerical unit brought forward to the School Committee at the last meeting on October 2, 2017 by Mr. Nagle who represents the clerical, cafeteria, and custodian units for SEIU Local 888. Mr. Marsh recused himself from this portion of the meeting as he is affiliated with SEIU Local 888.

Ms. Nicosia and Ms. DePersis of the Parent Information Center staff filed the grievance regarding the ELC Principal performing Kindergarten registration and follow-up with parents work that should be done by members of the SEIU Local 888 clerical unit. The SEIU Local 888 clerical unit asked Malden Public Schools (MPS) to provide a letter to memorialize that this nature of work should only be performed by members of the clerical unit.

Attorney Greenspan distributed copies of a draft letter to the SEIU Local 888 clerical unit to deny this grievance but acknowledge the point being made by the SEIU Local 888 clerical unit of the importance of only having members perform the relevant clerical work.

Mr. Iovino made the motion to deny the Level 3 clerical unit SEIU Local 888 grievance filed by Ms. Nicosia and Ms. DePersis. Mr. Leone seconded. A roll call vote was taken.
