Updates	McLean Hospital is continuing their work with teachers in our alternative program at the high school and expanding the consultation to include our school adjustment counselors. We held trainings to address our areas of improvement from our Tiered Focus Monitoring report and have submitted our first progress report.
New Information	<ul> <li>We will be transitioning to the DALS (digital assessment library) through Pearson this year. This will allow us to have a wider array of formal evaluations available. It will also be a cost savings in the future and eliminate buying hard test kits.</li> <li>We are bringing back the dedicated 504 coordinators, interviews are ongoing.</li> <li>IDEA grants have been submitted, with funds set aside to continue to address regression in special needs students as well as funding to update assessment system and other mental health and crisis needs.</li> </ul>






