Salemwood

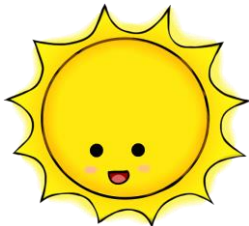

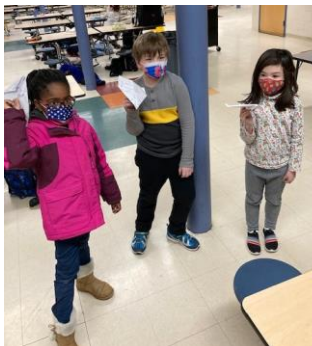


Chinese Culture Connection
