- Student Government New to Ferryway!!
 - 16 students elected to council last month
 - First meeting 3/9/22, with Asst. Superintendent to set guidelines
 - Looking into You Lead Conference, Melrose in May
 - Have the "Executive Branch" introduce themselves to grades 5-8 students
- Catapult Learning -
 - After school tutoring K-3 began last week
 - 3 days/ week, 40 minute sessions
 - 35 students signed on
 - Students made up those just under benchmark expectations
- ELT Summer Program is a GO!
 - Ferryway ran the program for the first time last summer
 - Total Enrichment program with academics included, K-8 students
 - Will combine with Salemwood students (former ELT school) this year
 - Showcase for 2 days over April vacation this year (W&TH, 8:30 12:30)
 - Students & teachers do not have to commit for the whole summer, 1 week at a time
 - DESE will be visiting, other districts to view over April vacation
 - All Free!!

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III. Review of School Committee Presentation

- 2nd most diverse school in MA (Just behind Malden HS)
- Great staff attendance
- Student attendance is at 91%
- Student Government
- ELT Program
- February Acceleration Academy for ELA & Math (3 days)
- Catapult Learning Update
- Empowering Minds social emotional learning curriculum used in grades K-8
 - Helps to support all students
- DESE Accountability data
 - Brought back 72% of students last year
 - 59% of students making progress toward our school improvement goal
 - Many different variables affecting data
 - Seem to be measuring alongside state
 - DIBELS (ELA) 5% improvement Fall to Winter
 - Overall 840 students in Fall 950 students in Winter (most new students have zero English language)
 - Gr 7 & Gr. 8 made the most growth to date
 - iReady Overall Growth went from 30 to 40% growth Fall to Winter
 - IXL (math) 30% at grade level Fall Winter 39% at grade level
 - New curriculum, Eureka, seems to be successful
- UnboundEd -
 - Schoolwide observations across the district last week
 - Focusing on "GLEAM" Grade Level, Engaging, Affirming, Meaningful instruction
 - Found Ferryway's structures were in place
 - Student assignments seemed to need more rigor
