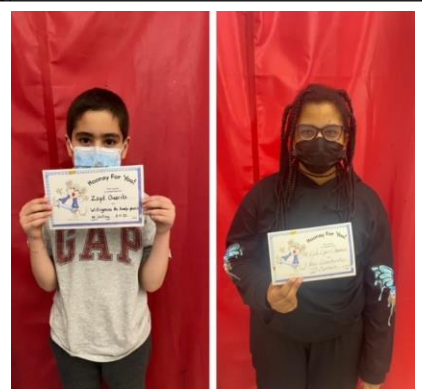
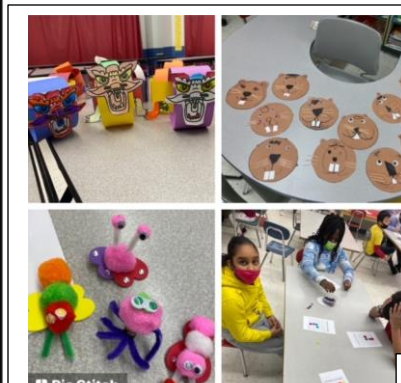

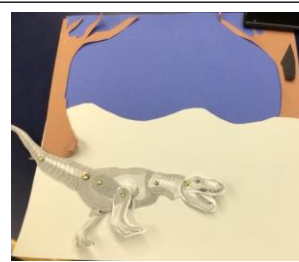


## Chinese Culture Connection
