

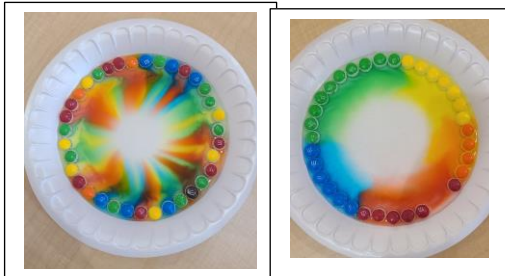


Malden Public Schools Out-of-School Time (MOST) March 2022

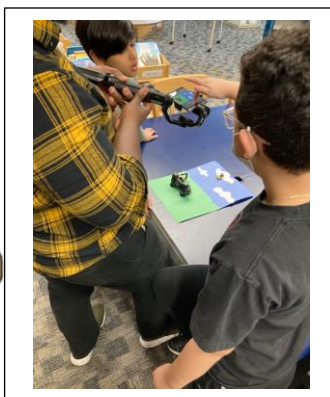
