

COVID Cases and Cleaning Protocols Updates

Cleaning and Sanitizing Protocols:

- Regular Classroom and Building Cleaning protocols are in place.
- All schools and central offices have hand sanitizers in every single main entrance,

Department of Elementary and Secondary Educations

Accountability information (DESE)

- 1. DESE school profiles will not include *progress toward improvement targets* yet due to the state determining that MCAS 2022 data is the new baseline for districts/state.
- 2. Statewide there were dips in MCAS results in ELA, Math and Science compared to MCAS 2019 data (pre-pandemic).
- 3. The 2022 ELA essay writing scores were at a record low across Massachusetts.
- 4. Student access to instruction was severely impacted due to absenteeism.
- 5. DESE advised districts to compare student growth between MCAS 2022 and MCAS 2019. This is due to the fact that the student growth percentile calculation used in 2021 was adjusted.
- 6. DESE is seeing signs of recovery in some grades and subjects across Massachusetts, as well as here in the Malden Public Schools.
