### Instructional Coherence and Alignment Highlights K-8 SY 2023-2024

#### Program of Studies Sy 2023-2024

### **Academic Highlights SY 2022-2023**

- District Annual growth on reading achieved a 23% increase in literacy
- Kindergarten had an increase of 53% at grade and above grade level reading
- In Math grades K-5, we had a 7% increase at or above grade level
- In Math grades 6-8, we had an 11% increase at or above grade level
- New Curricula: Literacy, Math, Science, History, Social Emotional Learning
- Pilot Honors Pathways Grades 6-8
  - 162 Students successfully received the Honors designation in their transcripts.
