Items in no particular order:

● **Update on technology support for all students - Supt. Noriega-Murphy**

- Currently have inventory of 7447 Chromebooks for student population, with 6440 assigned. Superintendent working with Policy committee Replacement and recovery procedures
- Administration(staff & faculty) technology replaced & upgraded for security and remote purposes (982 machines total between desktop & laptops)
- Providing staff/faculty training in use of Google Suite, including GChat

● **Update on online student registration**

- New forms for streamlining registration including multilingual support for all families
- Cut down on wait times and streamlines paperwork for families.
- Dashboard for families upcoming after other initiatives met.
- Where's my Bus and other initiatives in the pipeline.

● **Overview of technology across the district - A Rodrigues**

- Standardizing technology systems between school and city
- Service Level Agreement: Goals of downtime held to 14 minutes/day - up to 7 hours monthly
- Firewalls, WAPs and networks secured to prevent any future incursions with ongoing AI deployments
- New Intercoms in process of deployments
- New E-touch screens for all classrooms being deployed
- New Zoom deployment in the works for all staff
- Adding emergency access for Malden Police Department with cameras in case of any incidents in the school.

● **Stability of wifi and bandwidth across the district**

- Wireless Access Points upgraded to university level standards to provide seamless experience for students moving on to college.
- Upload time improved to accommodate bandwidth usage with average 40% to 50% extra unused capacity built-in to accommodate emergency or growth.
- Network re-architected for consistency and ease of management.
