Ms. Spadafora made the motion to authorize Attorney Greenspan to negotiate a 3.5% salary increase retroactive to July 1, 2020 for the 2020-2021 school year, a 3.5% increase for 2021-2022 and \$1,000 cash pandemic payment for all paraprofessionals who were working from November 2020 and still currently employed, increase scale of educational advancement credits as well as removing Step 1.
