


Graduation Rate:

(# students in 9th grade cohort who graduate in 4 years)/(# of first time 9th graders in cohort + transfers in - transfers out)


ADJUSTED Graduate Rate:

MHS 5-Year Graduation Rates




Dropout Rates

DESE Definition


A student in grade 6-12 who:

- was enrolled in school at some point during the current school year,
- 2. is <u>not</u> enrolled on the report date (10/1, 3/1, last day of school),
- has <u>not</u> graduated from high school or completed a state or district-approved educational program; and
- does <u>not</u> meet any of the following exclusionary conditions:
 - transfer to another public school district, private school, or state- or district-approved education program;
 - temporary school-approved absence due to suspension or illness; or
 - death


MHS Dropout Rate




Historical Dropout Rates by Grade Level

Historical Dropout Rates by Student Population




Mobility Rates





COVID: No testing

After COVID: one year of a MCAS pilot

Chronic absenteeism is defined by DESE as the percentage of students missing 10% or more of the days enrolled (e.g., 18 or more days absent if enrolled the entire 180 day school year). This includes excused and unexcused absences as this is about the amount of missed instruction, not the reason for the absence.
