





Woman in Wheel Chair Sues to Become Teacher

By ANDREW H. MALCOLM Judy Heumann, a 22-year-old polio victim, filed suit in Federal District Court yesterday for the right to become the city's first teacher in a wheel

Miss Heumann, who has passed the oral and written examinations required for a teacher's license here, charged that the Board of Education's refusal to give her a license discriminated against her be-cause she was physically handi-

capped.

Her lawyers said the case was the first such civil rights suit ever filed in a Federal court. They hope to make it a test case for a series of suits across the country guarantee-ing equal job and education rights for the physically handicapped, whom her lawyer called "one of our forgotten minori-
