

- School Council Guidelines
 - o Reviewed guidelines and discussed more effective ways to increase our membership next year
 - Collaboration with PTO was very helpful, will build off that in 2024-25
- Moving Up Day & Placement Letters
 - Class Placement Letters were sent home with supply lists for their next grade-level
 - Physical letters with the kids on June 11th
 - Emailed letters to parents on June 14th
 - Move-Up Day was a big success at the school as all the students were reorganized and spent time in their new classrooms for next year with their new teachers and classmates
 - Any parent who didn't get the placement letter or supply lists can contact the school this summer
- Summer School Options
 - o If a 6, 7, or 8th grader failed subjects, they were assigned mandatory summer school
 - There are many programs going on throughout the city that have been advertised through our Blackboard system, newsletter, and social media platforms
 - At Ferryway this summer we only have a specialized summer program for students,







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it is not available for public application

- The city of Malden has many opportunities through their rec department and parents should contact Joe Levine or his office to keep their children busy this summer
- Facilities Review & Summer Repairs
 - There are no major repairs at the school this summer other than addressing the flashing/leaking over the CWing first floor classrooms
 - As a result of construction at other schools, our school will house a larger number of classrooms and perhaps admin teams from other schools this summer
- Staffing Review & Summer Hiring
 - Last summer we have 42 positions to fill and through organization, recruiting, and determination all were filled
 - Through that same level of organization, the number of positions to fill this year is back to a normal attrition rate for a school with 90+ teachers
 - The interview and hiring process will begin once the positions are posted
- Student Incident & Attendance Data
 - Behavioral incidents and out of school suspensions both decreased significantly this year
 - Incidents overall all, based on a data review, were down over 20%
 - Out of school suspensions, based on a data review, were down upwards of 90%
 - Attendance rates also demonstrated significant improvement
 - Overall attendance rose from 92.9% last year for students to 94.1% this year
 - Chronic absenteeism decreased from 23.1% to 18.1%
 - The accountability target number for us, set by the DESE, was 21.6%
 - That means, based on a preliminary data review, we exceeded that goal by 3.5%
